

PE Kit

For the health and safety of all, please can you ensure that your child is correctly prepared for P.E. lessons? Due to a number of recent issues we would like to remind you of school policy here at Oxton St. Saviour's CE (Aided) Primary School.

- Long hair needs to be tied back (boys and girls). It is suggested that they keep spare bobbles in their kit bag, as school can only provide them with an elastic band.
- Jewellery and watches should not be worn. Necklaces, friendship bracelets and earrings need to be removed. In the case of studs that cannot be removed please provide Micropore tape or similar to cover them.
- Girls will be expected to remove tights for P.E. lessons. They should keep a few pairs of socks in their kit bag if required, else they will have to go bare-legged.
- All children require a pair of black pumps with rubber soles for indoor use AND trainers for outdoor.

P.E. kit– White t-shirt, blue shorts, trainers that are suitable for sport (all white, black or grey only). Tracksuit bottoms and sweatshirt for colder weather (Navy blue only).

KS2 Swimming

Boys: Trunks or short, fitted shorts (long or baggy shorts are NOT permitted) and towel

Girls: Swimming costume (no bikinis) and towel.

School P.E kit and footwear for the walk up to the pool.

Extra-curricular clubs

School clubs – Bring in own sportswear as requested in letters.

Clubs run by outside agencies (e.g. Fencing/ Judo Education) As instructed in their letters, this may differ from school kit.
