I understand that the teacher in charge of the party will be acting in loco parentis and in the event of an accident I agree to my son/daughter receiving emergency medical treatment, which might include the use of anaesthetic and blood transfusions, as considered necessary by the medical authorities present.

The school has taken out Comprehensive School Journey Insurance through a private company which contains, amongst other covers, Personal Accident Insurance cover. Details are available on request.

I understand the extent and limitations of the insurance cover provided and that Wirral Borough Council is insured in respect of its legal liabilities only, and that there is no personal accident or other insurance cover unless I have been advised specifically by the organiser. Accidents may arise for which Wirral Borough Council is not legally liable. I may choose to obtain suitable insurance to cover such eventualities. I acknowledge that I have provided school with up to date/current medical information relating to my child including emergency contact details.
