Dear Parents/Carers,

The Prime Minister announced new measures and advice to the general public in relation to Covid-19. The following advice supersedes all previous advice given and should be read carefully. If your child is well they should attend school. However, if they present with any symptoms below then they should remain at home in isolation for 14 days;

- A high temperature **and/or**
- A new continuous cough

In addition, anyone in the same household should also self-isolate for 14 days regardless of whether they have symptoms themselves. Moreover, any child who presents these symptoms at school will be isolated and parents will be called immediately.

It is also advised to stop non-essential contact with others and to stop all unnecessary travel. The Prime Minister also added 'We need people to start working from home where they possibly can and should avoid pubs, clubs, theatres and other such social venues.' These are wide ranging decisions that will affect all of us in some way.

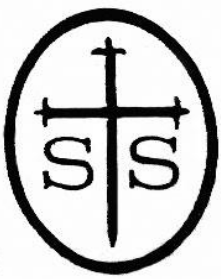
As a school we are making preparations to enable learning to continue for those families that are isolated from school or in the possible event of closure. We have set up a Home Learning tab on the school website:
