<p>One of the most famous cake recipes that as survived from Roman times is one for honey cakes. Make some of these cakes at home and take a photo (or bring in a sample) Did you like them? OR find and make another Roman recipe of your choosing.</p>	<p>Draw a clock face using Roman Numerals. List the Roman numerals from 1 to 20</p>	<p>What lasting effects did the Romans have on Britain? For example money, parliament, roads, towns, architecture, clocks. Which Roman legacy do you think was the most influential on modern day Britain? Write an explanation and give a reason for your opinion.</p>	<p>Design and create a poster advertising a Roman Bath House. Why should people go there, what are the benefits of using the bath house? Think about hygiene and social benefits. You can do this by hand or on the computer using publisher.</p>	<p>Research what toys Roman children played with and draw an example. Are any of the toys similar to ones we have today?</p>
<p>Write an adventure story set in Roman Britain. Remember you will have to think of a dilemma and how it will be solved.</p>	<p>Make a list of objects that we would use now that the Romans used and a list of objects the Romans used that we don't use now</p>	<p>Write a short newspaper report announcing the invasion of Britain (Include a Catchy Headline!) (Decide whether you're a Roman or British newspaper first.)</p>	<p>Write a food diary for one day as if you were member of a rich Roman household. Write your own food diary for a day. Compare them.</p>	<p>Find as many countries as possible that the Romans invaded. Draw their flags and write a sentence about the country to go with each flag.</p>
<p>Write your own Roman poem. Can you include a simile or alliteration?</p>	<p>Research the Roman Gods and then design your own God for the Romans.</p>	<p>Write a secret message in Roman numerals (with an alphabet key)</p>	<p>Make a leaflet advertising a fictional Roman museum or other tourist attraction.</p>	<p>Create a quiz of Roman facts. You could do this in a Power point presentation or on little quiz cards.</p>
<p>Design and draw a Roman outfit for a slave and/ or a rich person</p>	<p>Plan a trip that your family could go on across the UK visiting only Roman towns and using as many Roman roads as possible.</p>	<p>Dress up as someone from Roman times. Have your photo taken and write a caption to go with it.</p>	<p>Research roman weaponry and create a fact sheet. (This can be done on paper or on the computer).</p>	<p>To make a model of a roman weapon, including drawings or picture off your chosen weapon.</p>
