Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you for all of your support over the last few weeks and for your patience while we have been planning how to safely reintegrate your children back to school.

We request that pupils change clothes daily as this is recommended by our health and safety consultant and is part of the school risk assessment. Children can wear their PE kits or summer uniform.

As you are aware we have building works ongoing in school which means the top gate on the car park cannot be accessed. The only entry point for the children is via the playground gate, this could potentially become a bottleneck if everyone arrives at the same time. Therefore, we would like you to arrive at 15 minute intervals starting from 8:00am. Please drop your child off at the gate and a member of staff will escort them to their base. Please can you adhere to these times in order for this to run smoothly.

Pick up times will be from 3:00pm to 4.30pm from Little Acorns and myself or Miss Shaw will go and collect your child.

We envisage having around 50 children in next week each day. They will be in a 'bubble' of up to a maximum of 11 pupils from their year group with at least 2 members of staff per 'bubble'. They will remain with this group throughout the day. Could you please provide your child with a packed lunch, which they will eat in class, as well as a bottle of water as the water fountains are not in use. The kitchen is currently closed due to building work and sandwiches are being delivered for the universal free school meal pupils (Reception and KS1) and free school meal pupils. Do not bring your child to school if you or your child are displaying any symptoms of coronavirus (following the [COVID-19: guidance for households with possible coronavirus infection](#)).

Can only one parent accompany your child/children to school in order to limit the number of people entering the school grounds.

Standards of hygiene will be high and any contact points and frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned regularly using virucidal cleaner. The children will not be sharing equipment in class, everything will be provided for them – do not send your child into school with any items other than a water bottle and lunchbox. The children will be completing the home learning tasks set by their class teacher and will be at a desk separate from the other pupils. There will be a rota for playtimes and lunchtimes, again to minimise contact between 'bubbles'.

Summary of initial reintegration plan:

- Drop off at playground gate from 8:00am at 15 minute intervals. There will be 2 metre intervals marked on the fence to support social distancing.
- Children to change clothes daily – PE kit or summer uniform.
- Children do not need to bring any equipment into school apart from lunchbox and water bottles.
- There will be no work sent home.
- One parent to drop off at the gate and pick up.
- If you or your child are showing any symptoms of coronavirus do not bring your child to school.
- Children will remain in their 'bubble' for the day – there will be no opportunities for the bubbles to mix.
- Pick up from Little Acorns from 3:00pm to 4.30pm.
