Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you for all of your support over the last few weeks and for your patience while we have been planning how to safely reintegrate your children back to school. Year six pupils will be able to return to school on **Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June**.

**Unless you are a key worker, drop off time is 9.30am and pick up is 3.30pm.** We would like the later drop off time to avoid the rest of the key worker children as they arrive.

Please wait on the playground 2 metres apart - the children will be picked up and dismissed by a member of staff. There will also be 2 metre intervals marked in purple on the school fence. Please observe these and support social distancing whilst entering the school gates and on the school playground.

Miss Gerrard, Mrs Shields and Miss Shaw will be teaching the children. Depending on numbers the children will be divided into two groups and we will be using the Year five and six class rooms. At playtime (and for sports sessions) they will be able to be together but will not be allowed to mix with any other 'bubbles'.

Could you please provide your child with a packed lunch, which they will eat in class, as well as a bottle of water as the water fountains are not in use. Do not bring your child to school if you, your child or any other household member are displaying any symptoms of coronavirus (following the [COVID-19: guidance for households with possible coronavirus infection](#)). Only one parent must accompany your child/children to school in order to limit the number of people entering the school grounds.

We request that pupils change clothes daily as this is recommended by our health and safety consultant and forms part of the school risk assessment. **Children can wear their PE kits or summer uniform.** Standards of hygiene will be high and any contact points and frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned regularly using virucidal cleaner. The children will not be sharing equipment in class, everything will be provided for them – do not send your child into school with any items other than a water bottle and lunchbox. The children will be completing the home learning tasks set by their class teacher and will be at a desk separate from the other pupils. There will be a rota for playtimes and lunchtimes, again to minimise contact between 'bubbles'.

**Please let us know as soon as possible if you would like a Year 6 place by emailing [schoolplaces@oxtonstsaviours.wirral.sch.uk](mailto:schoolplaces@oxtonstsaviours.wirral.sch.uk). If we do not hear from you by 1.00pm on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June, we will assume you do not want to take up a place.**

Finally please be reminded it is not a prerequisite that your child attends – the choice is entirely yours and we will respect your decision.

### Summary of initial Year six reintegration plan:

- Drop off on playground at 9.30am – two metre intervals marked on the fence to support social distancing.
- Children to change clothes daily – PE kit or summer uniform.
- Children must not bring any equipment into school apart from lunchbox and water bottles.
- There will be no work sent home.
- Only one parent permitted to drop off/pick up
- If you, your child or any other household member are showing any symptoms of coronavirus do not bring your child to school.
- Children will remain in their 'bubbles' for the day – there will be no opportunities for the bubbles to mix.
- Pick up from playground at 3.30pm (unless you are a keyworker)
