As you are probably aware the final guidance for schools was released on Friday at 7.30pm. Apologies for final arrangements being so late. Your child's PE days have been emailed out and are on the website under letters on the top bar. This will start from this week – Years 2 and 3 will have PE on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September.

### **Drop off and Pick up Routine**

The timetable for drop off times have been emailed out and are on the website under letters titled 'school day information for September'. If you have more than one child please drop off your child at your oldest child's time. **Please use the normal gate for dropping off and then exit via the car park gate.** All junior children to now go through the hall door as there is a loose step on the entrance by Year 1. **One adult to drop off and pick up.** We would prefer if you wore a mask to drop off and pick up, however, this is not mandatory.

When you pick up there will be marked areas to wait to aid the teachers when dismissing the children. Please note Year 2 children to be dismissed to parents on the Junior Yard. We will send older siblings down at the earlier pick up time so that you do not have to wait. Please exit using the playground gate as soon as possible to enable the next pick up time to run smoothly and safely.

### **Lunch time Routine**



**Children do not need to bring in their own stationery.**


