Year Two	<p>Easter is celebrated in many different countries. Why? How is Easter celebrated around the world? Why is Easter important to Christians?</p> <p>Shabbat-This is a Jewish holy day. (not strictly a festival) Why is it special for Jewish people? Is there a special day like this for Christians? How are they the same?/ different?</p>
