





The club is open every day during term time, excluding inset days.


Our dedicated, qualified staff are here to care for your child and ensure that they are happy and having fun.



#### **Openining Hours**

Morning Session 7.45am - 8.45am

After School Session 3.15pm - 5.45pm

On the last day of each term (Christmas, Easter and Summer) school closes at 2.00pm. On these dates Little Acorns closes at 4.15pm.

Children will only be released from the afternoon club to an adult listed on school records.

If a child has not been collected by 5.45pm, parents will be contacted in the first instance by telephone. If club staff are unable to contact parents, they will then telephone the contacts provided by parents on the 'additional contacts' list. Three late pick ups within each half term will result in a child's place being reviewed and possibly cancelled. Late collection is any time after 5.45pm.

We understand that emergency bookings or late collections do occur on rare occasions. To leave a message for the Acorns Team please call 0151 652 4909 and select option 2. Alternatively call/text the clubs emergency number on 07544007081.

#### Cost

We offer a reduced rate for pupil premium pupils and families with more than two children in attendance at the club. Please speak to the school office for more details.

#### Bookings & Payment

Parents don't need to apply for their child's place in advance of joining the school as we operate a 'Pay As You Go' system. Parents must, however, book and pay for their child's place online via ParentPay in advance, providing they have credit in their ParentPay account. All bookings and changes must be made no later than midnight the night before. This deadline is in place to ensure the club is adequately staffed and resourced for the following day.

Booking in advance can be on a daily, weekly or even half termly basis. The maximum number permitted on the ParentPay booking system is 100 days in advance.





All bookings must be confirmed and paid for within 2 hours of selecting them; failure to do so will result in the bookings being automatically cancelled.

#### How to book:

- 1. Login in to ParentPay
- 2. Select 'pay for other items'
- 3. Click/view the club you require i.e. Morning Club or After School' at the top please note your balance is shown at the top! If you want to top-up put your chosen amount in the 'choose payment amount box'
- 4. To book click 'book meals and places'
- 5. Click on blue bar 'make or view bookings' If using a mobile device, its useful at this point to turn phone landscape for a full view of the week!
- 6. Click on the day/days you want to book these will turn green and tick will appear. If you want to book a few weeks in advance, click on the 'next week arrow top right.
- 7. Scroll down and select 'confirm booking' (blue box) a message will appear to confirm 'your bookings have been successfully confirmed'

#### Childcare Vouchers / HMRC Tax Free Scheme

School accepts childcare voucher payments form a variety of providers including; Edenred, Fideliti, Bravo Benefits, Computershare, Kiddivouchers and Care-4. Upon making a payment via a provider, the company send the school office confirmation of this payment. Upon receiving this notification, the school office will then 'credit' the pupil's account. This credit/top up is processed as close as reasonably possible to receiving the notification.

If you pay via the HMRC TFC scheme, your payment will only be processed if you inform Mrs Curran in the School Office with the date of payment and the amount.

Important: Please bear in mind the school office is closed during school holidays. If voucher or TFC payments are made during the holidays, your account will not be credited until school re-opens. Planning ahead and being in credit at all times is key to ensuring you can book at any time!
