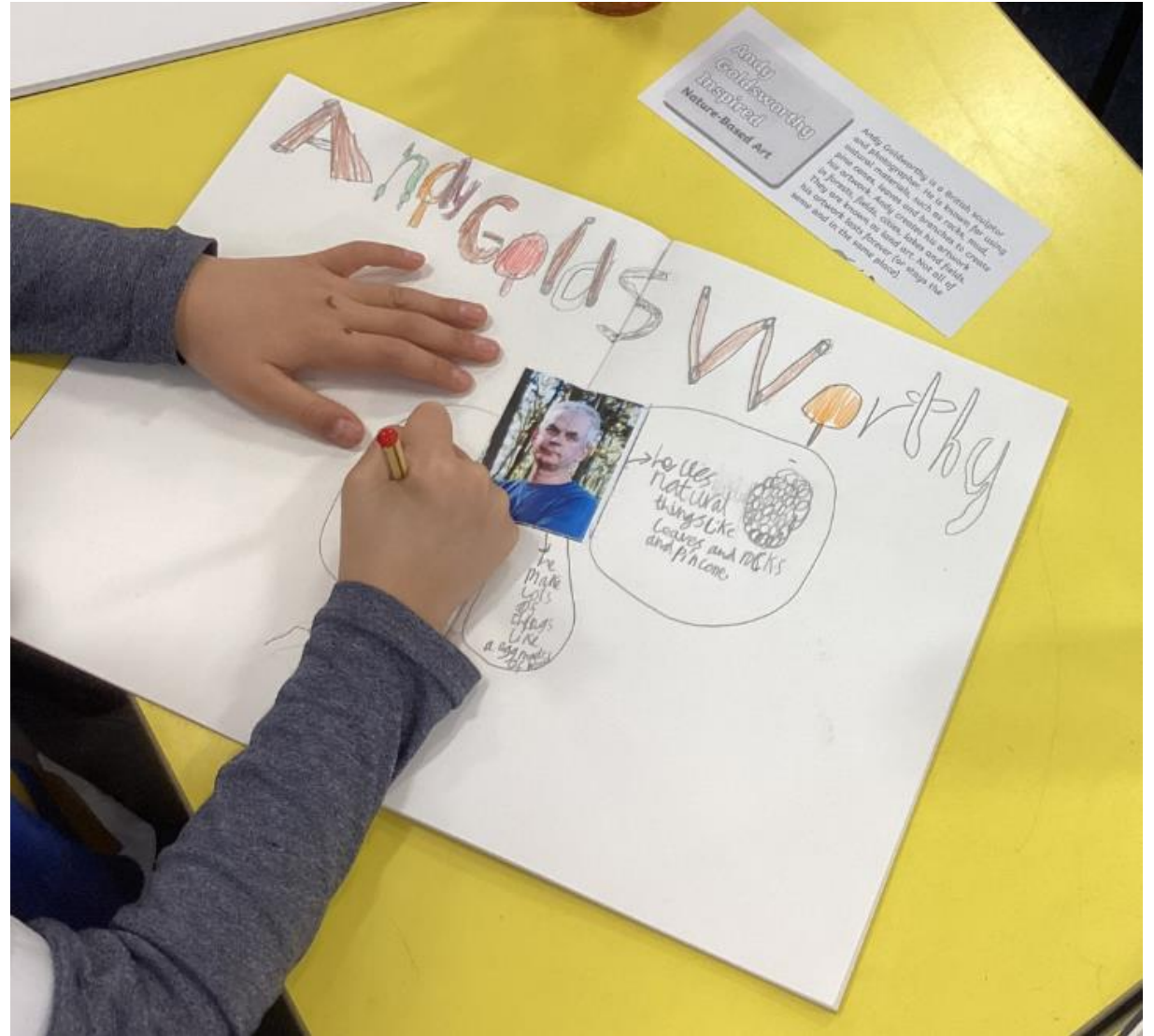

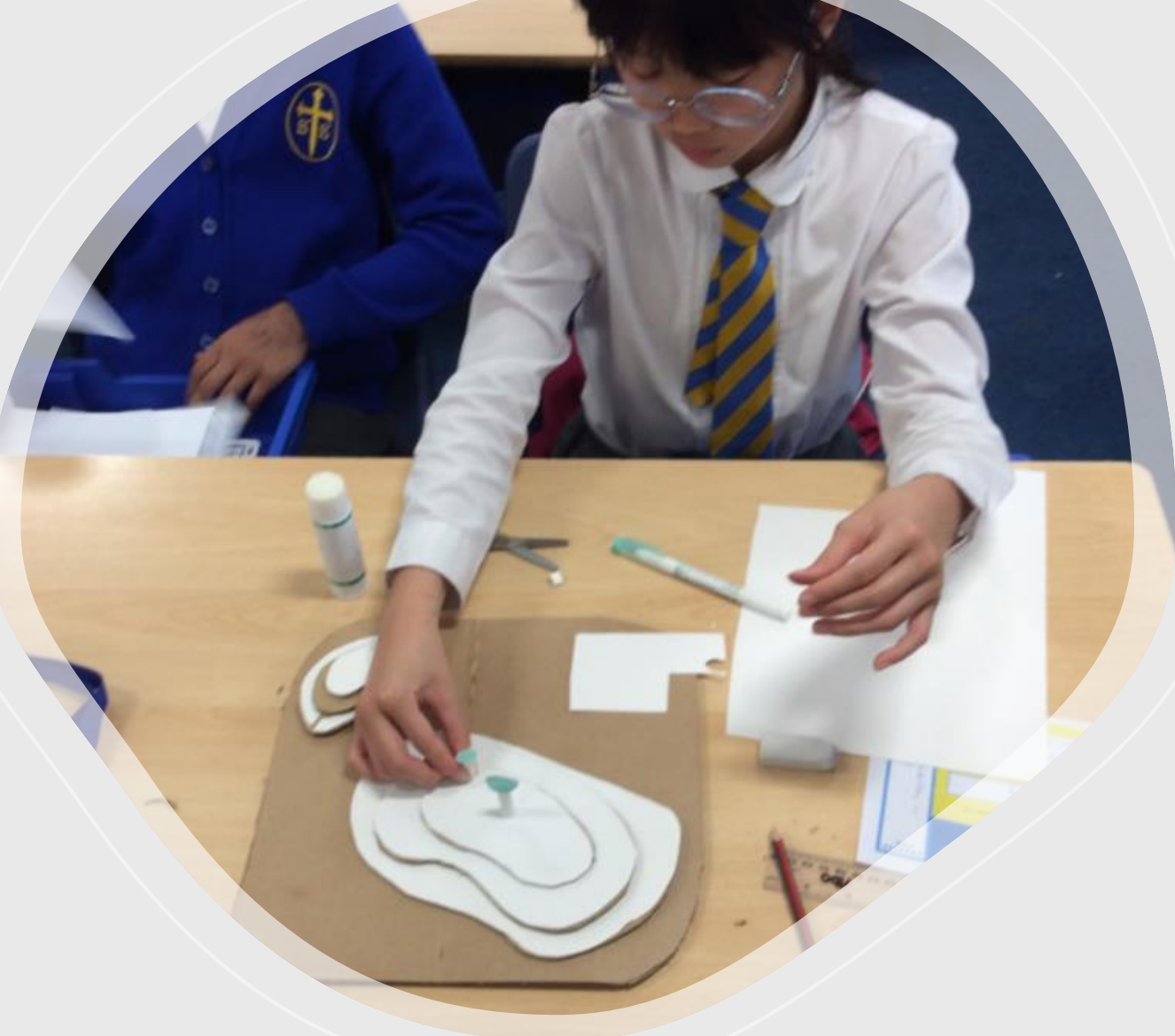

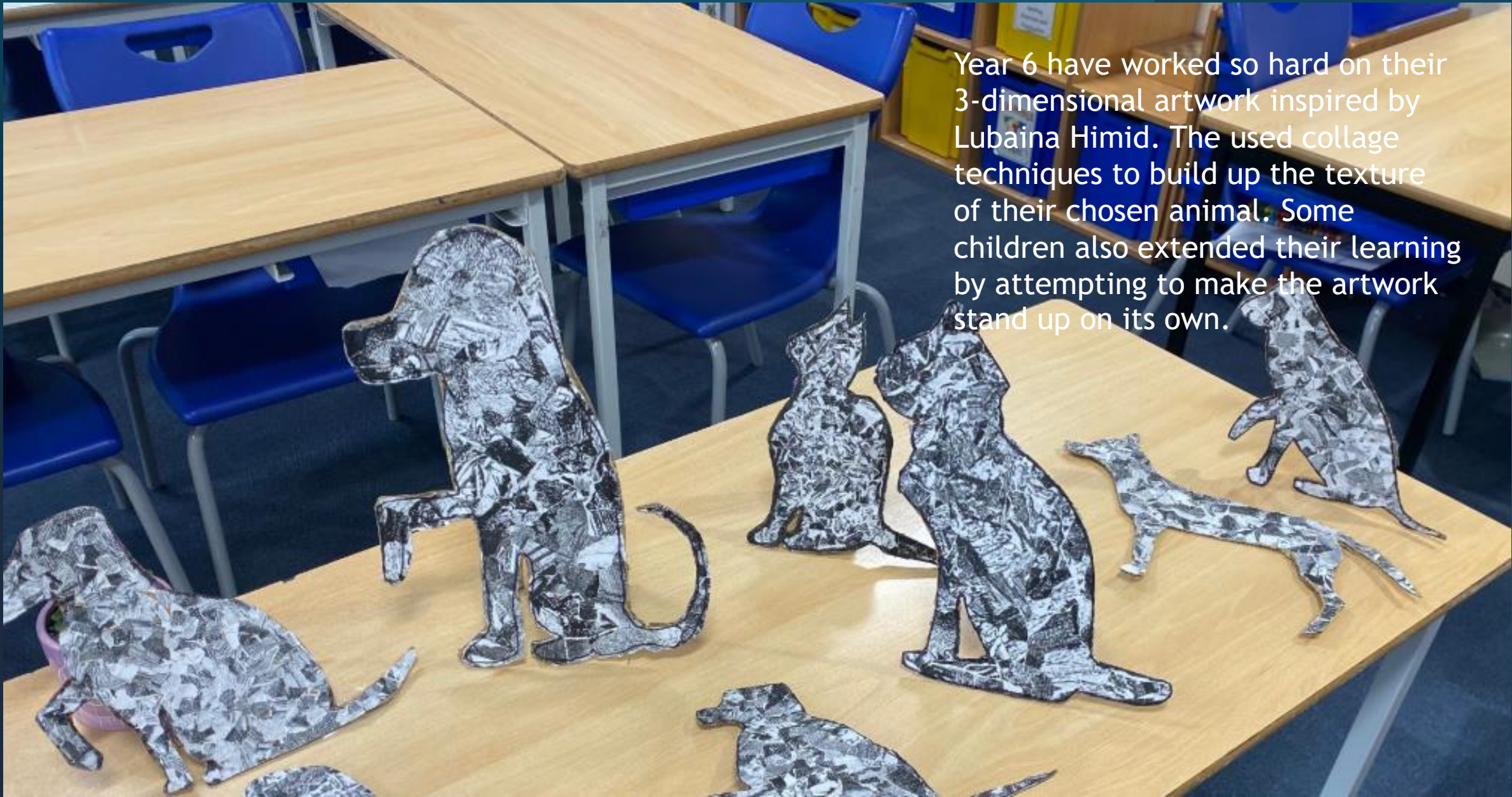




Year 6 Lubalukova prints
