

# Oxton St Saviour's CE Aided Primary School Home-School Agreement

This simple agreement outlines effective ways in which we can agree to work together to foster and maintain respectful and pro-active relations.

## As a school we will:

- promote Christian values and develop an active partnership between the church, school, parents and the wider community
- ensure that every member of our community feels valued and respected and that each person is treated fairly and well
- allow children safe and secure use of the internet through a combination of site filtering, supervision and by fostering a responsible attitude in all pupils, in partnership with parents
- promote the **'Ready, Respectful and Safe'** rules and to create an environment where exemplary behaviour is at the heart of productive learning
- encourage all children to work to the best of their ability
- inform parents of what the teachers aim to teach each term and their child's progress and of any areas where additional support may be needed
- provide appropriate homework for each child and ensure this is consistent across the school
- be open and welcoming
- encourage respect for others and their property
- value the part that children play within the school and wider community

## As a pupil I will:

- follow Christian values and show respect to all members of our community
- work to achieve my best in all areas of my learning
- complete and return homework on time
- value the part I play within the school and wider community
- maintain the highest standards of personal conduct, to accept responsibility for their behaviour and encourage others to do the same
- follow the "Ready, Respectful and Safe." rules:

**READY:** I will be ready to learn by arriving at school on time, have my equipment ready and will show that I am listening.

**RESPECTFUL:** I listen when others speak and respect the property of my friends and the school.

**SAFE:** I will move around school in a safe manner; follow instructions to keep safe both in school and when we are on a school trip; I will use equipment safely and stay safe online.

## As a parent/carer I will:

- uphold Christian values and be respectful to all members of our school community.
- ensure that my child attends school regularly, arrives on time - I will inform the school as early as possible if my child will be absent
- ensure that my child upholds the school dress code/uniform
- make every effort to attend open evenings to discuss my child's progress
- support the school's policies
- support the rules of 'Ready, Respect and Safe'
- support school in the teaching of safe and secure internet use at home
- encourage my child to respect all property, including school grounds, ensuring they use the appropriate pathway
- endeavour to provide support and guidance for the completion of homework tasks and nurture home learning
- make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour
- encourage my child to be sensible, respectful and safe on-line
